Fingernails Policy

Jifis International School fingernails policy is part of the safety policies of the school.

- 1. Parents are to have their wards' fingernails well-trimmed and filed always. Learners' fingernails should be neatly trimmed and filed on a daily basis.
- 2. Teachers and all staff members are to have their fingernails well-trimmed and filed always. Wearing of artificial nails to school is prohibited.
- Teachers are to inspect learners' fingernails daily. Learners with grown fingernails are to have the nails trimmed by the class teachers and have a report made to the office for parents to be surcharged 20 cedis per session of trimming nails.
 - Older learners who are able to should be made to trim the fingernails before they enter the classroom.
- 4. Teachers who entertain grown fingernails in the classroom will be sanctioned (Sanction per number of learners with grown fingernails).
