Fingernails Policy

Jifis International School fingernails policy is part of the safety policies of the school.

1. Parents are to have their wards' fingernails well-trimmed and filed always. Learners' fingernails should be neatly trimmed and filed on a daily basis.
2. Teachers and all staff members are to have their fingernails well-trimmed and filed always. Wearing of artificial nails to school is prohibited.
3. Teachers are to inspect learners' fingernails daily. Learners with grown fingernails are to have the nails trimmed by the class teachers and have a report made to the office for parents to be surcharged 20 cedis per session of trimming nails.
Older learners who are able to should be made to trim the fingernails before they enter the classroom.
4. Teachers who entertain grown fingernails in the classroom will be sanctioned (Sanction per number of learners with grown fingernails).
